- Government strategy to stop people becoming involved in violent
- Early engagement with people showing signs of radicalisation.
- Refers people to the multi-agency process 'Channel'.
- Interventions are delivered through channel which is made up of local authority and the police.

What are the 4 P's of Prevent?

Introduction to Prevent

1. **Prevent** – stopping people becoming terrorists or supporting violent extremism.
2. **Pursue** – stopping terrorist attacks
3. **Protect** – strengthening protection against terrorist attacks
4. **Prepare** – where an attack cannot be stopped, mitigating its impact

What is the aim of Prevent?

The Prevent duty aims to **safeguard people from becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism**. Prevent is part of CONTEST, the Government's counter-terrorism strategy. It aims to stop people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism and violent extremism.

WHAT ARE BRITISH VALUES?



- **DEMOCRACY** Is a system of government in which all the people in Britain are involved in making decisions through voting to elect representatives to a parliament e.g. How laws come about through a democratic process.
- **RULE OF LAW** Implies that every citizen is subject to the law, including law makers themselves e.g. Health and Safety laws and regulations.
- **INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY** Can be thought of as freedom limited by rights, and therefore cannot be abused e.g. Discussion about career choices with learners.
- **MUTUAL RESPECT & TOLERANCE** Can be defined as a feeling that something or someone is good, valuable or important, shared between two or more people. We believe that respecting the people who keep us safe is an important part of this value. We care for each other's thoughts and feelings.

They are linked to:

- The PREVENT Agenda which instils good practice of British values amongst staff
- Acting as a preventative measure against radicalisation and extremism, but is a vital part preparing young adults to get on in life
- Critical thinkers and active citizens who respect others and challenge prejudice and discrimination
